Sioux County Conservation Foundation

A new non-profit organization has been formed in Sioux County with the mission of: "Providing resources for the enhancement, preservation, and enjoyment of nature in Sioux County." The Sioux County Conservation Foundation has a 501C3 status, and is made up of five board members. They are Dawn DeWit of Rock Valley, Brian VanEngen of Sioux Center, Gordon Pottebaum of Alton, Greg Hansen of Hospers, and Stan Hoekstra of Hawarden. The board meets once a month at Sandy Hollow. The current project in planning is a Nature Center in Sioux County. The Nature Center will provide a place for families and individuals to learn more about our natural environment, and will house the Sioux County Conservation Board Environmental Education Program and offices.

The location will be at Oak Grove Park, in Deer Run Campground, overlooking the prairie. It is the thought of the committee that Oak Grove provides the natural diversity and richness that this center needs. The Nature Center will not only encourage visitors, but will be the "hub" of the nature trail system at Oak Grove, leading adventurers into the prairie, to the pond, river, woodlands, and savanna. The summer camps and field trips offered by the Sioux County Conservation Board will take place at the new center as well. Nursing home picnics, civic organizations, and others will be invited to come for environmental education programs or a tour of the center.

At this point, the committee has toured other nature centers and are ready to start putting ideas on paper. Fundraising has started for this project as well. Contributions are welcome and appreciated. Please contact the above email if interested.

Ruling on Firewood: The Sioux County Conservation Board has a new policy on firewood. You may bring in your own fire wood as long as it is within a 30 mile radius of the campground you are staying in, and does not cross state lines (this is a state law to not cross state line due to Emerald Ash Boer).

We will continue to provide fire wood at our camping locations: Oak Grove Park, Big Sioux Recreation Area, and Sandy Hollow. Firewood is \$4 an armload.

Budding Naturalists

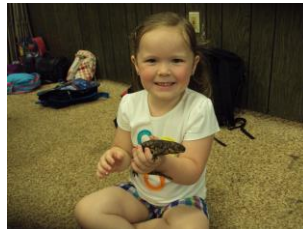
